From the juvenile division, she moved on to the felony trial division. It was there that she put her energies into helping her clients in any way possible. She once had a client who was from Ethiopia and only spoke Amharic. She found a translator to work with him. She sought out someone familiar with the customs of people from Ethiopia so she could better understand him and what had happened. And when he asked for a Bible, she personally bought him one in his native language. When the jail somehow lost his first one, she bought him a second one. In January 2020, she moved to her current position in the office's appellate division.

Miranda has always had a heart for those that have the misfortune to fall between the cracks due to lack of family support, that may have been innocent, or received severe, unfair sentences. She supports equal and fair justice, working hard at usually lower salaries to do what she can as an attorney while raising four children that attend Humble schools. She is married to Matthew Mahony, currently an Associate Principal at Summer Creek High School.
