ICM has been in ministry for over 30 years and has built over 10,000 churches, hope centers and orphanages in over 90 countries. Boys and Girls Country provides homes to children ages 5 to 18. Children live on campus in cottages with trained houseparents and attend local public schools. They are a trauma informed community that provides for the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of each child. A Sheltered Life fundraising events have collected over \$1,400,000 and helped build over 40 orphanages, hope centers, as well as helping Boys and Girls Country locally.

Not only is he a partner in two very successful companies, but he also sits on the boards of several charities, including, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Latin America North. This board is presided over by another Humble alum, Eric Anderson. FCA is a group that works to see the world transformed by Jesus Christ through the influence of coaches and athletes.
