In addition to the PBS series, she is also host of National Geographic's digital series "Round Trip with Colleen Kelly", taking over Nat Geo's social channels and creating and hosting a YouTube series that reaches over 50 million viewers and subscribers. Under this same brand of "Round Trip", Colleen is the host of a Chicago WLS radio show which airs to Chicago and 38 states and is also a podcast on Apple, Amazon and Spotify.

Colleen is a well known and recognized on air Travel Expert and has appeared nationally on Fox & Friends and The Hallmark Channel and has been featured in many national magazines and publications of all kinds.

In addition, in Chicago, where she is now based, she regularly appears and shares her expert travel tips on ABC, NBC and WGN, Chicago's number one television station.

As an Emmy-nominated executive producer, travel expert, engaging television personality, and seasoned talk show host, Kelly has worked with clients all around the world, internationally and domestically, while producing content of the highest level of production for National Geographic, Travel + Leisure, PBS, Travel Channel, and Parents.
