Humble High School, Class of 1964

Charles (Andy) Curry is a proud graduate of the Humble High School Class of 1964. Andy is dedicated to supporting the Humble community and remained here after graduation, serving the city he loves.

Charles joined the United States Air Force in 1965 and was discharged in 1969. He was stationed at McChord AFB in Tacoma, Washington, in Osan, Korea and various areas of Southeast Asia.



After being discharged from the Air Force, he attended Southwest Texas State University and earned his BBA in 1972. After graduation, he went to work for Stewart & Stevens and the Bank of the Southwest in Houston.

Charles went to work for Humble Independent School District in 1975, serving as finance director for the Superintendent of Schools at that time, George Turner. He earned his MBA in 1977. After his service in the finance department, Charles was named the Director of Data Processing for Humble ISD under the leadership of Humble ISD Superintendent, Dr. Michael Say. The Data Processing department grew from a desktop computer with a 10mg hard disc to the district-wide in-house computer network that it was when he retired in 2003. He continued to contract with other school districts with database management and programming services.

In addition to his professional work with Humble ISD, he has chosen a life of public service. Charles was first elected to the Humble City Council 1999 and served until 2011 when he decided not to run again. However, he did run again in 2013 and has been on the Council since then. Over that time, he has watched the city continue to grow and so has his drive to assist the citizens of Humble.

Charles and his wife, Naomi, Humble High School class of 1965, are proud Wildcats and active in the Humble High School Alumni Association. The two serve as co-chair of the Humble High School Alumni Celebration held each June.
