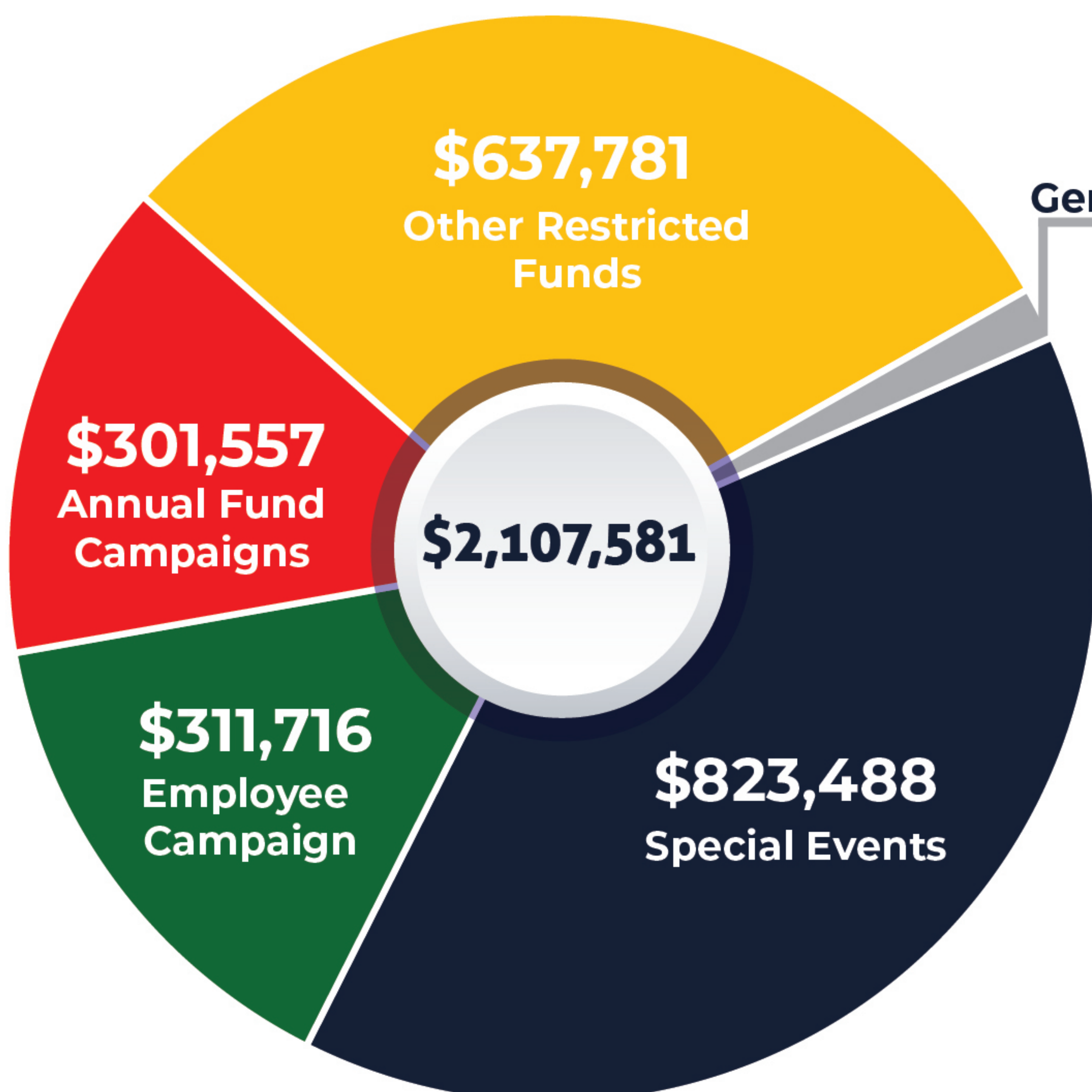

- Students with speech challenges will use touchscreen technology to communicate with their peers.

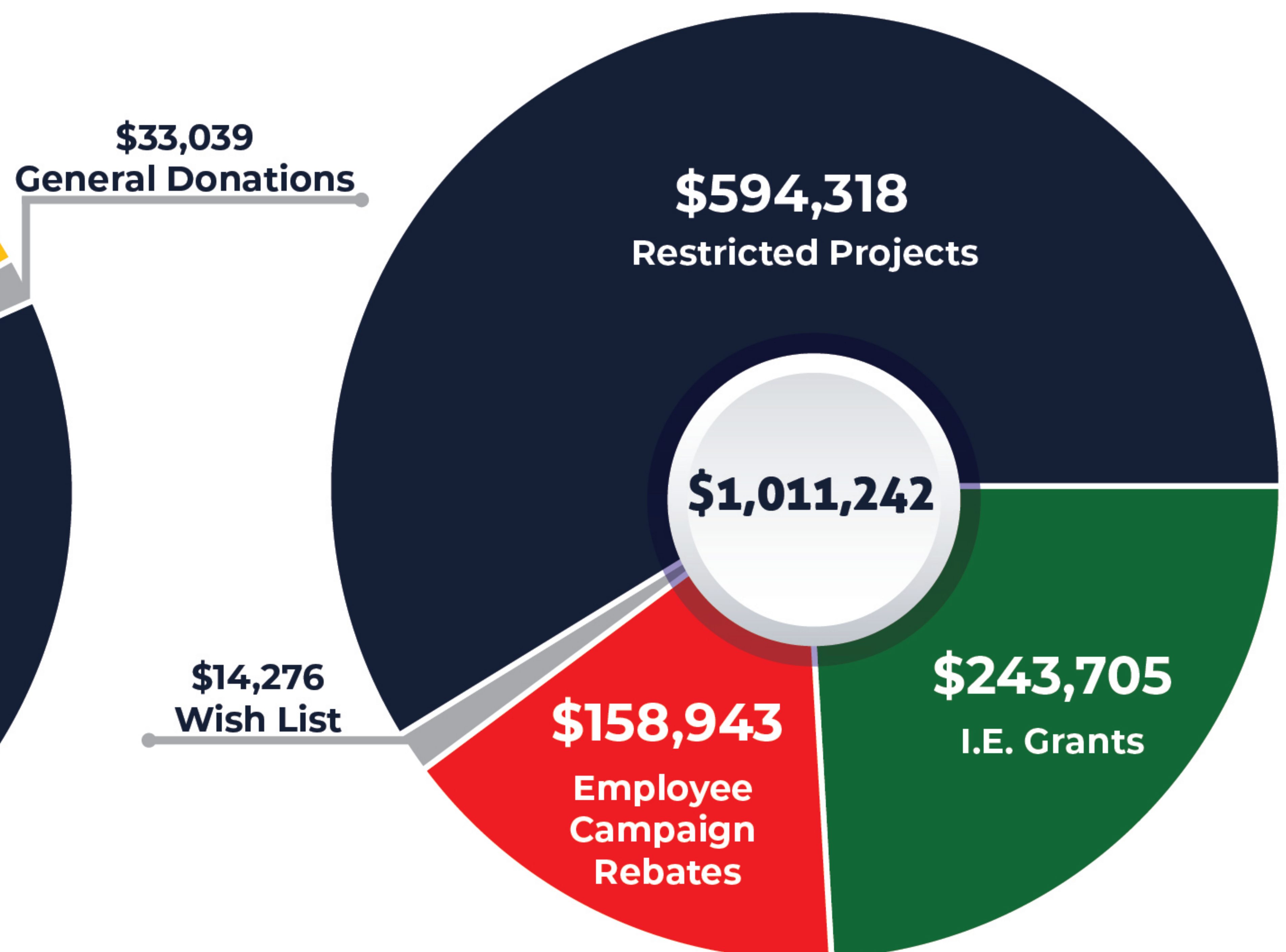

Grants in Action

Enriching student learning experiences & allowing educators to dream BIG!

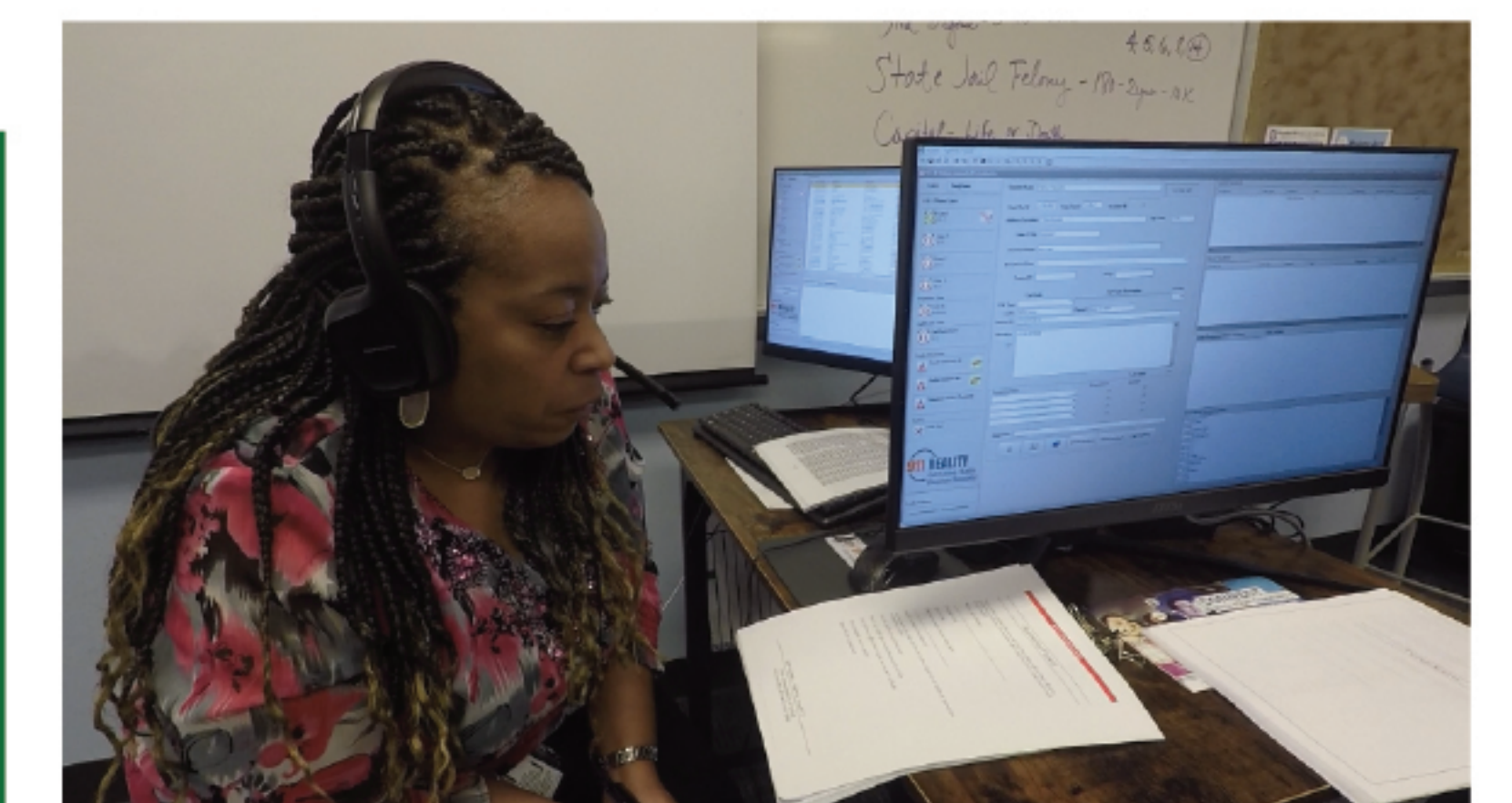
The Foundation's Innovative Education Grant Program funded **67 innovative projects** in May 2022. The awards, totaling **\$243,705**, enriched student learning experiences and allowed educators to apply new strategies in and out of their classrooms.

911 What's Your Emergency project helped to fill the national gap the United States is facing in having skilled emergency communications employees ready to work. Through this project, Kingwood High School students enrolled in the Law and Public Safety classes were able to sit for the National Emergency Communications Certification which is required for job applicants seeking a career as 911 operators. The 911 training center that was created from these grant funds gave students hands-on call center training.

This program will prepare students to succeed in a world that is increasingly oriented toward highly skilled jobs by developing critical thinkers and global citizens. "Instead of just learning about a career by reading about it, these students got to live in it as they simulated situations in the call center. They are better prepared to pass the certification exam and ready to pursue job opportunities right out of high school," said Janet Collins, Kingwood High School educator.



With the investment of a private foundation, students at Atascocita High School and Humble High School will participate in this certification program next year and begin their career-ready journey after high school.

The FUNctional, Inclusive Playground Communication project transformed the playground at Foster Elementary into an inclusive learning and play environment. With the addition of the communication board, students bridged the gap between verbal and nonverbal communication. Amber McKellar, Speech Language Pathologist at Foster Elementary, said, "The implementation of this core board has been a resounding success measured by the numerous observations of students with varying special needs and communication levels engaging together with a common interest of exploring and utilizing the core board."



The success of the communication board at Foster Elementary and others that we funded demonstrated the need for this resource. Humble ISD will now fund the addition of a communication board to all new playgrounds at elementary school campuses across the district.



Empowering Future Leaders

This year, the Humble ISD Education Foundation partnered with local organizations and donors to award **189 scholarships** to graduating seniors totaling **\$199,350**.

We cannot wait to see what the future holds for these students. We love to hear from previous scholarship recipients and hear about their journey. Ariaah Watson graduated from Summer Creek High School in 2018 and received the Humble Area Retired Teacher Association Scholarship and the Wang’s Martial Arts Scholarship. After graduation, Ariaah attended the University of Texas at Austin and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Communications Sciences and Disorders and in Health Communication. She is now a first-year graduate student in the UT Master’s Program for Speech-Language and Hearing Sciences. Ariaah said, “The scholarships I received allowed me to pursue a career in Speech Pathology to help assess and treat individuals with speech, language, and swallowing disorders. Because this Foundation has financially supported me through my academic years, I am able to pursue my passion for advancing the quality of life for others.”

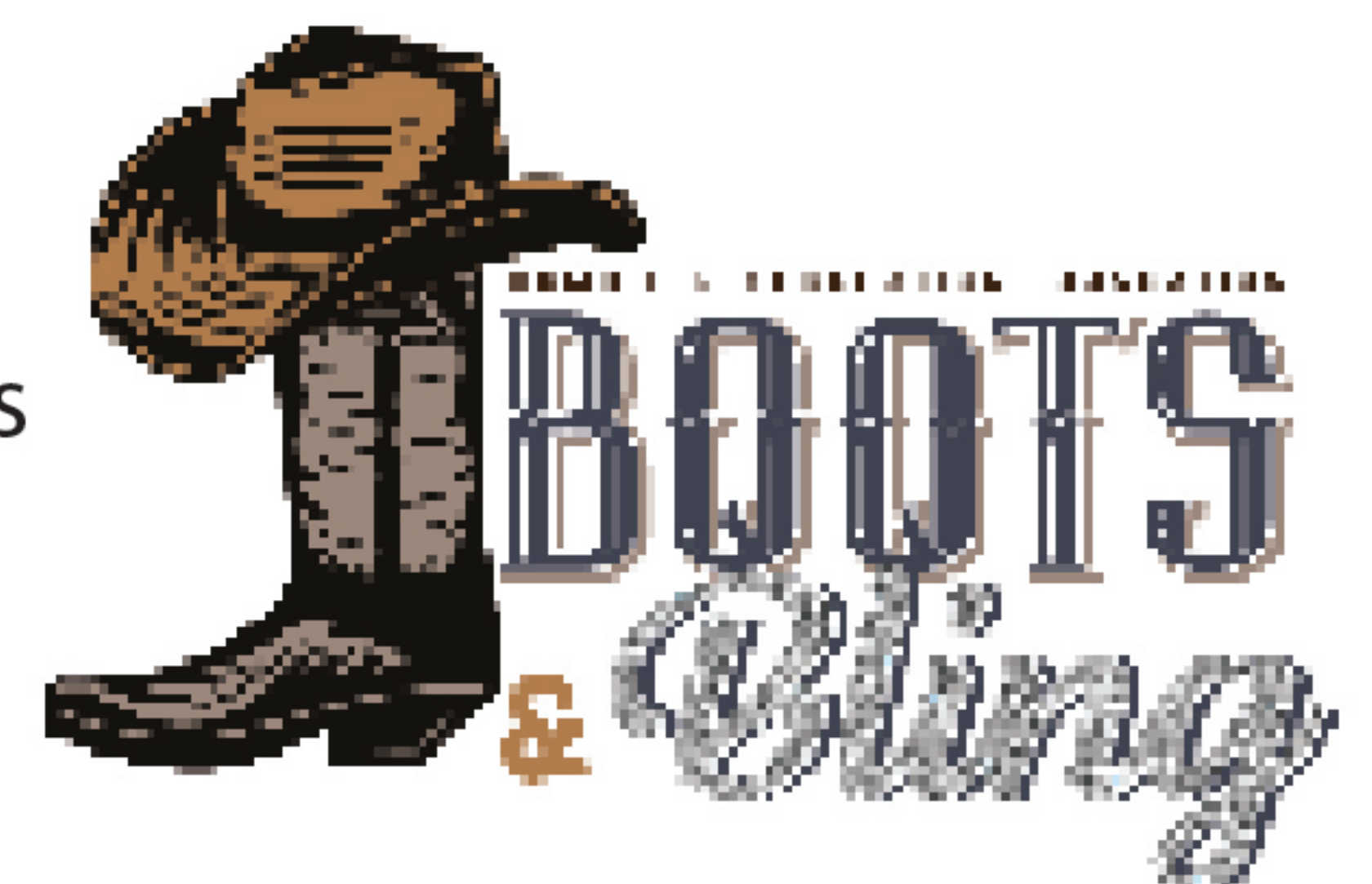
HUMBLE RODEO & BBQ COOK-OFF
